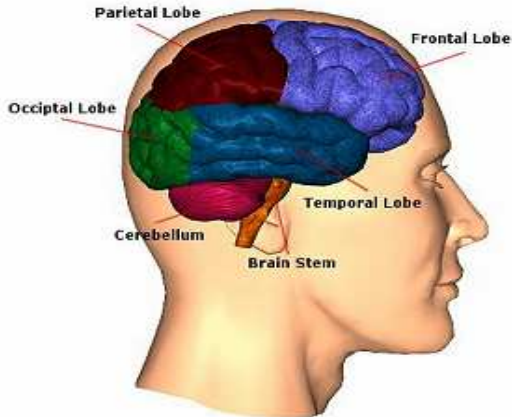


DRUG ADDICTION IS A BRAIN DISEASE THAT CAN BE TREATED

Knowledge is a powerful tool in the understanding and the treatment of substance use and abuse.

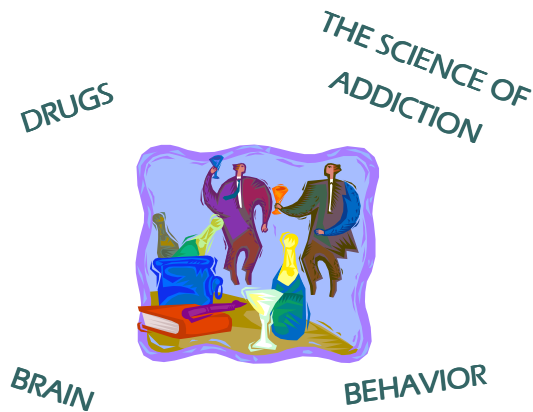
This five session program can help explain how drug use over time can cause brain changes that impair a person's ability to make sound decisions.
